



IF-Weinheim – NVR activities for 2015

At the institute for systemic education and development Weinheim (oldest institute for systemic therapy in Germany) we offer an education in “[systemic parental coaching and professional presence](#)”, based on a hierarchy of different seminars: a basic seminar, an in-depth-training seminar, three different seminars of free choice to special disorders like anxiety, trauma, school distance, aggressive behavior etc and a final two-day supervision seminar (all in all 14 days).

In 2015 we went on in continuing and developing our curriculum in team exchange. We did this particularly with regard to the application in different practice areas, especially for social workers and family helpers, who are working with parents, therapists and teachers with difficult behavior patterns.

We integrated results from other research areas, e.g. in family business by Arist von Schlippe and we have published different articles concerning the NVR.

We continued networking within our institute and other organizations and colleagues from outside e.g. Austria and Switzerland.

Currently, we prepare a conference together with Haim Omer, Arist von Schlippe from 2nd to 4th of March 2017 with the title “intelligent paths for networking”. This conference is intended to show successful networking and positive examples and makes suggestions for a better cooperation between professionals and support for parents.
